SPECIALIST DIPLOMA 1

(COURSE CODE: SDHM)

The Specialist Diploma in Hospitality Management (SDHM) course allows students to acquire knowledge in key subject areas that will prepare them to take advantage of the diverse opportunities in the rapidly growing sectors of tourism, hospitality and related businesses. It will also provide students with the knowledge and understanding of the various activities within the tourism and hospitality industries. Students will study and develop skills related to front office operations, restaurant management, facilities management including housekeeping, customer service and communications in the English language.

(COURSE CODE: DTHM)

The Diploma in Tourism and Hospitality Management (DTHM) expose students to global tourism and hospitality practices; while providing them with a good understanding of recent trends and ethical issues that exist in the dynamic and fast-paced tourism industry. While AAC will make its best efforts to secure Industrial Attachment for the students, it does not guarantee that it will be able to secure one for every student.

(COURSE CODE: BAIHM / BAITM)

BA(Hons) International Hospitality Management (Top-Up) - BAIHM is designed to give the student the management and operational skills needed to succeed in the hospitality industry of the 2020s and beyond.
