### Description

This 'O' Level Examinations are Secondary School graduating Examinations jointly held by the Ministry of Education Singapore in conjunction with the University of Cambridge of Local Examinations Syndicate.

The Singapore-Cambridge "O" Level Certificate is universally recognized particularly in Commonwealth Countries and the US.

Students are prepared to sit for monthly, termly, and semester tests that meet the MOE school curriculum. These tests provide students the opportunity to practice and learn the necessary topics for the GCE O Level examination.

### Qualification Entry Requirements

#### Academic

- Applications must be at least 15 years of age of 1st January of the GCE 'O' level examinations year
- Completion of Secondary 2 or equivalent

#### English Proficiency

- Pass Placement test or Certificate in EFL Level 1
