The Specialist Diploma in Hospitality Management (SDHM) course allows students to acquire knowledge in key subject areas that will prepare them to take advantage of the diverse opportunities in the rapidly growing tourism, hospitality and related businesses. It will also provide students with the knowledge and understanding of the various activities within the tourism and hospitality industries. Students will study and develop skills related to front office operations, restaurant management, facilities management including housekeeping, customer service and communications in the English language.

Entry Qualification Requirements

Academic

- At least C6 for any GCE O Level subject or
- 10 years of formal education or equivalent

English Proficiency

- IELTS 5.0 or
- AAC EFL Level-4 or
- Pass AAC English proficiency test

Students without formal English qualification will be given a placement test to determine the level of proficiency, and if the level of English proficiency is insufficient, a suitable course can be organised.

Applicants must be of age 16 or above

Duration :

In the event that a student is unable to participate in the Industrial Attachment module due to circumstances beyond the control of the student or the College, like non-approval of the Training Work Permit by Ministry of Manpower, the student will be required to complete a Research-Based Project with the submission of a report to be considered for graduation for the course.
